Please welcome our new church secretary, Kristi Vallee. Feel free to stop by and introduce yourself!

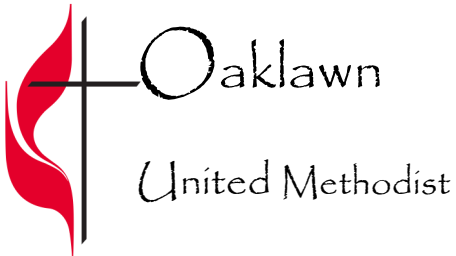

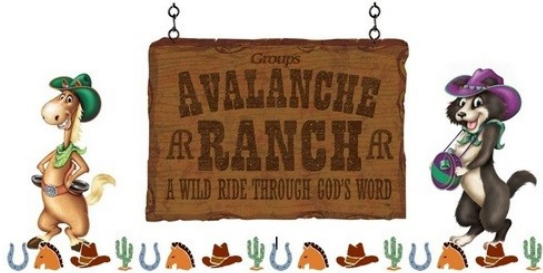
